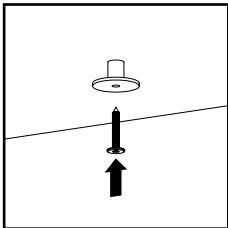
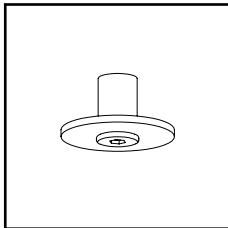


Spiral shown extended for illustration purposes.

Installing the fixing brackets

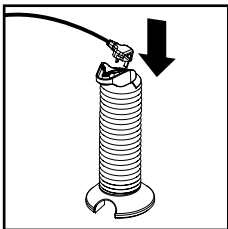


Attach the top hat to the underside of the desk with the supplied fixing screw.

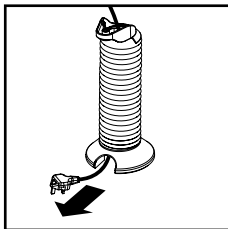


Ensure the top hat is secured firmly in place but do not overtighten the screw.

Installing the cables

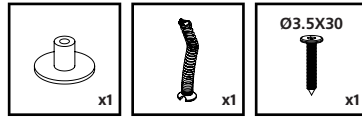


With the cable spine in the collapsed state, feed the cables through the top aperture as shown.

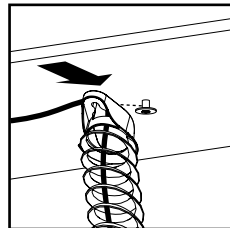


Guide the cables out of the base and through the recess to allow the base to sit flat.

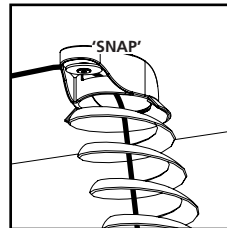

Installing the cable spine (top)

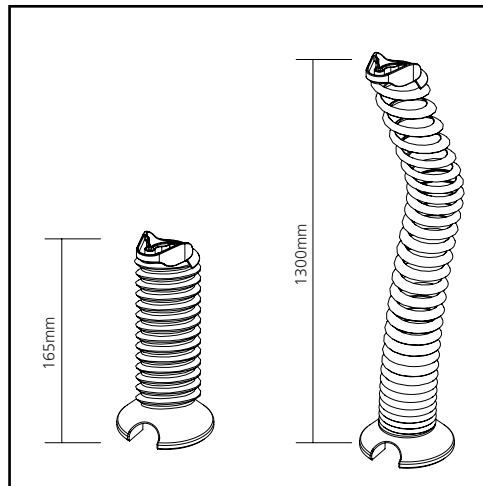


Guide the slot on top of the cable spine onto the top hat fixing under the desk.



Push the top of the cable spine towards the top hat until it snaps into place.

Cable spine adjustment



The cable spine can be used up to a maximum height of 1300mm. The collapsed height of the cable spine is 165mm.

Safety
